Welcome!

Thank you for choosing to spend some of your time with us here at Camp Living Waters! We are excited to have you and trust you will enjoy a relaxing and fun time here at camp! The following information of our policies and expectations of our guests will help ensure everyone has a fun and safe summer so we can all enjoy God's creation for His glory.

Hours of Operation

Check In will be **6PM** Monday through Saturday with **Check Out** at **1PM** Tuesday through Sunday. Our campus will be closed on Monday which means although you may check in at 6PM there will be no meals or programmed activities available. (Outside food is not permitted in cabins.)

Meals

We will offer meals though our Dinning Hall Tuesday Breakfast through Sunday Lunch. **No outside food will be permitted in the cabins.** Friday evenings we will have an all campus Hoedown in which dinner will be served at our Living Waters Camp Ground Pavilion. We hope you plan your stay to join us for a fun evening at the Ranch!!

Lodging

All lodging will be assigned by Camp Living Waters at the time of registration depending on availability and number of guests within your family unit.

Cabins

Our cabins are placed strategically throughout our main camp property easily accessible to all our activities and main buildings. Please remember to bring your own twin sized bedding, pillows, towels, & toiletries as these are not provided. Most cabins are furnished with one full size bed.

Camp Ground

We have both Full & Partial Hookup sites in our scenic Living Waters Camp Ground. All sites have Water & Electric with access to our beautiful Bath House and Pavilion. Each site is equipped with it's own picnic table & fire ring for your enjoyment.

We also have two A-Frame cabins with two rustic beds in each. They share a fire ring and also have access to our Bath House & Pavilion. These house a maximum of 4 adults or a family of six with small children.

Tents are welcome as well. Limit two tents per site & a maximum of eight people.

Policies

- **Social Distancing** - We ask that guests be considerate of others as we do our best to provide social distancing options to everyone. Meals and Programmed Activities will all be scheduled as Family Unit times and social distancing practices in place.
- **Food** - Please no outside food in the Cabins. Meals are to either be purchased at registration, throughout your stay, or while you are out and about in the surrounding areas. This will help us keep our facilities clean and safe from unwanted insects & wildlife within our grounds. Thank you for your cooperation.
 - There is to be no alcohol on Camp Living Waters property at any time.
 - Please help us keep our property clean & safe by disposing of all trash in the appropriate containers located throughout the property.
 - There is no smoking in any Camp Living Waters buildings. Please dispose of butts in trash containers throughout the property.
- **Pets** - Pets are not permitted in the Cabins. They are permitted on our Camp Ground with the following restrictions:
 - No animal is to be left unattended outside of a RV or A-Frame Cabin.
 - No animal is to be left unattended inside or outside of a tent.
 - Animals not associated with Camp Living Waters are to be on a leash at all times, no exceptions.
 - The owner will assume all responsibilities & liabilities of the actions of their animal. Including cleaning up after them and making full restitution for any damages incurred to Camp Living Waters property, the property of other guests or people.
 - Camp Living Waters will not be liable for any injuries, illnesses, death, or harm to any animal while it is on our property.

- Animals not associated with Camp Living Waters are not permitted at the Ranch.
 - Animals are not permitted at the Waterfront.
 - **ORVs** - Please use consideration and caution of others while driving on Camp Living Waters property to get to the State Trails. Due to programmed activities happening throughout our property in multiple locations, ORVs are not permitted to drive anywhere other than on the main road in and out of camp while on Camp property. Thank you for your cooperation.
 - **WaterFront** - The Waterfront will be open Tuesday through Sunday afternoon from 1PM - 5PM. As a courtesy to our guests we will have a Waterfront Director on duty during these hours. Wading, fishing (Bring your own equipment), & boating are available all day.
 - Parents are responsible for the care and wellbeing of their children at all times while at Camp Living Waters.
 - Minors are not to be left unattended at the Waterfront.
 - We ask that all swim attire be modest. Please no bikinis, speedos, etc.
 - Life jackets (these are provided) are required to use Camp Living Water boats.
 - No animals are permitted at the Waterfront.
